The Role

- Classification: Part-time, 24 hours/week (Full-time considered), hybrid 70% in office
- Compensation: \$40,000 – \$46,000 annually (DOE, bilingual status, and interest/readiness providing clinical supervision - training may be provided by NCC)

- Provide 15 hours of direct counseling per week (including early evening hours at least 2 days/wk).
- Conduct assessments, diagnosis, and treatment planning for a wide variety of clients.
- Facilitate occasional psycho-educational workshops.

- Participate in staff meetings and the Quality Assurance Committee.
- Support organizational health and occasional fundraising activities.
