The Falmouth Police Department is accepting applications for the full-time, sworn position of **Police Officer**. Every candidate must meet the minimum certification standards set by KRS 15.382.

FULL-TIME & SWORN

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Required for certification under KRS 15.382

- ✓ United States citizen
- ✓ At least 21 years old — you may apply at 20, but must turn 21 before graduating the DOCJT Basic Training Academy
- ✓ High school graduate or High School Equivalency Diploma (GED)
- ✓ Valid Kentucky driver's license
- ✓ Willing to be fingerprinted for a state and federal criminal background check
- ✓ No felony conviction, and none of the disqualifying misdemeanor or sexual offenses listed in KRS 15.382
- ✓ Not prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a firearm
- ✓ No dishonorable, bad conduct, or general discharge under other than honorable conditions from any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces
- ✓ Have received and read the Kentucky Law Enforcement Officers Code of Ethics
- ✓ Able to pass the medical exam, drug screening, and psychological screening required by the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE

- ✓ High school diploma or equivalent required
- ✓ Associate's degree in criminal justice or a related field preferred, but not required
- ✓ Any equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Peace Officer Professional Standards (POPS) certification from the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council — or eligibility and willingness to complete the DOCJT Basic Training Academy
- ✓ Successful completion of the Police Academy
- ✓ New officers may be required to sign a reimbursement and continued-employment agreement under KRS 70.290

HOW TO APPLY

Pick up an application at Falmouth City Hall, 230 Main Street, or at the Police Department, 212 Main Street, Monday through Friday during normal business hours. Applications are also available online at cityoffalmouth.com.

Return your completed application in person, or email it to the Chief of Police. Questions are welcome at any point in the process.
