Position Summary:

The College is recruiting a temporary full-time Maintenance Technician for a one-month contract. This role will provide support to the maintenance team in ensuring the proper operation and upkeep of campus buildings, including mechanical systems, as well as maintaining the overall condition of the campus grounds.

Main Responsibilities:

- General grounds maintenance, including leaf blowing and removal, lawn mowing, raking, daily routine tasks, snow removal, etc.
- Daily campus maintenance and repairs through the work order system (maintenance ticket system), including:
 - Electrical work (replacing light bulbs and switches, appliance troubleshooting, etc.)
 - Plumbing repairs (clearing clogged sinks and toilets, faucet replacement, troubleshooting water leaks, etc.)
