### Position 1

Working with [Dr. Shelby Yamamoto](#), EEH Associate Professor, [CCCHE](#), the Postdoctoral Associate will work on research projects focused on **climate change, air pollution, and other environmental exposures in relation to aging, social inequities, and health**. Research related to climate change mitigation and adaptation will also be supported.

### Position 2

Working with [Dr. Mark M. Janko](#), EEH Assistant Professor, [CCCHE](#), the Postdoctoral Associate will conduct **research on the health impacts of climate change, with a focus on vector-borne diseases in the Amazon and Congo Basins**. The research will involve developing historical and future climate scenarios—including counterfactuals—and integrating them with health surveillance and related data to estimate climate-attributable risk under Deep Uncertainty.

### Position 3

Working with [Dr. Kelly Baker](#), EEH Associate Professor, [CCCHE](#), the Postdoctoral Associate will work on **research integrating One Health concepts and evaluation approaches into urban climate resiliency initiatives in the US and globally**. We are interested in candidates from a variety of backgrounds in climate and One Health.

- Doctoral degree in a related field.
