Open-Rank Tenure-Stream Position in Risk Management and Insurance

To help us build on the Fox School's tradition of excellence in risk management and insurance, the Department of Risk, Actuarial Science, Healthcare Management and Legal Studies at Temple University seeks a full-time tenured or tenure-track scholar at the Assistant, Associate, or Professor level with research and teaching interests in Risk Management and Insurance. The anticipated employment start date is July 1, 2026. Qualified candidates should hold a Ph.D. in Risk Management and Insurance, Economics, Finance, or a related field. For junior scholars, the degree should be completed by August 15, 2026.

Additional desired qualifications include (the potential for) excellence in RMI scholarship, as demonstrated by publications in leading field journals and/or general outlets in business and economics; the ability for high-quality teaching; and service commensurate with rank, including doctoral student supervision as appropriate.

To receive full consideration, interested candidates should apply by October 26, 2025. To apply, submit the following five documents (preferably in pdf format) by email to rihmhire@temple.edu:

- (1) a letter of interest for the position (no more than 2 pages);
- (2) a current curriculum vita;
- (3) a statement of research interests, primarily forward-looking (no more than 4 pages);
- (4) a statement of teaching interests, including summary information of student evaluations (no more than 4 pages); and
- (5) names and contact information of three references; we will solicit letters as appropriate.
