Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW) is an award-winning, medium-hub commercial service airport that served more than a record-breaking 11 million passengers in 2024 and is one of the top 50 airports in the United States for passenger traffic. Fifteen airlines serve RSW with nonstop service to 70 markets, including Canada and Germany. The economic impact of the airport is \$8.3 billion annually to the Southwest Florida region and more than 60,000 jobs. Page Field (FMY), an FAA-designated reliever airport, provides services to general and business aviation and accommodated 169,000 aircraft operations in 2024. Base Operations at Page Field is an award-winning, fixed-based operator and has been recognized for its customer service and facilities.

This includes critical public safety, security and other operational systems such as the 800 MHz radio system, Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, Video Management Systems (VMS) and Access Control System (ACS).

• Ensures the 800 MHz radios, CAD system, VMSs, ACS, and all other AOCC technology and software applications function efficiently and effectively on a 24/7 basis

- Troubleshoots and serves as the point of contact for any technical issues and service outages reported by direct users of any AOCC technology system
- Works directly with LCPA IT, LCPA Maintenance, Motorola, software application vendors and County stakeholders
  to ensure that issues are reported and promptly resolved
- Coordinate with LCPA IT to research, identify, and implement any additional applications or technology solutions
  that will assist the AOCC
- Creates and delivers training to AOCC personnel on the proper use and functionality of all systems
- Works with the department director, airport police liaison, and airport rescue & firefighting liaison to implement CAD response configurations, map changes and updates, event types, and deployment records

#### Minimum Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age or older and possess a valid Florida driver's license
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
- Must obtain and maintain all Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) requirements for unescorted access throughout LCPA properties
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years of experience in public safety technology or aviation technology systems.
- Demonstrated expertise in the operation and maintenance of systems similar to those identified in this job description (800 MHz radio systems, CAD, VMS, ACS) is highly preferred

**Schedule:** Although this position is primarily expected on-site during business hours, it requires the ability to work different shifts (nights, weekends and holidays) depending upon the needs of the department and may be adjusted periodically. This position is subject to holdover or recall on a 24-hour basis for essential services and emergencies.
