Lee County Port Authority (Authority) invites the submission of electronic bids from all interested and qualified individuals, corporations, partnerships, and other legal entities authorized to do business in the state of Florida to compete for the opportunity to provide the goods or perform the services specified in this Request for Bids (RFB). The Authority is accepting electronic submissions in OpenGov until Monday, April 20, 2026, before 2:00 p.m., local time. Bids sent in any manner other than electronically to OpenGov will not be accepted. **Hard copies, faxed bids, and electronically submitted bids sent directly to the Authority will not be accepted.**
