- Practice respectful, unhurried care routines — feeding, diapering, and sleep treated as one-to-one moments of connection and language, never as interruptions to be rushed
- Protect uninterrupted freedom of movement; observe and support each infant's own gross-motor progression rather than positioning or propping
- Observe and record each child's development, and use those observations to adapt the environment
- Partner closely with parents day to day — feeding and sleep communication, and steady support for families separating from an infant for the first time
- Maintain scrupulous health, hygiene, safe-sleep, and ratio standards
- Mentor and direct an assistant teacher
